We are pleased to be able to report that significant progress has been made in restoring normal capacity levels at Vishay manufacturing facilities in China. All facilities are now operating at a minimum of 80% of capacity prior to the Coronavirus outbreak, and many are at approximately 90% or better.

While this additional capacity will allow us to fulfill your orders more quickly, we do expect continued impact on deliveries as we work through the existing backlog. Our expectation is that delivery delays will diminish in the days and weeks ahead, and we thank you for your continued understanding.

You are also no doubt aware of the Coronavirus outbreak that has impacted Northern Italy. Please note that Vishay facilities in Italy have not been impacted by the virus, and continue to operate normally. It is perhaps worth noting that other Vishay facilities in Europe, as well as facilities in the Americas, also continue to operate normally.

We will continue to update you on our actions as the situation requires. Your local Vishay sales representatives will continue to provide the most up to date information available for your specific orders.
